Vocabulary building activities

Language Focus

These activities assist in the development of students' vocabulary knowledge. The meaning of new words is learned by comparing and

contrasting it with words already known.

Materials

- Magazines, catalogues and a scrapbook

Procedure

- Shopping list– students are to make a shopping list using magazines and catalogues. where they are found– bakery/butcher etc)
